#### A review of Trial 5

What a collection of weather systems this trial has received! Winter 24/25 was one of the wettest, Spring '25 was one of the driest and Summer '25 was one of the sunniest on record. This year the roses have been very happy with little or no rain because we have an irrigation system that we can put on when needed. The lack of rain has helped with reduction of blackspot, while the hot weather caused rust to show up earlier than expected, something that our breeders have also noted. In general, it has been a good year: the roses are still producing plenty of bud and will continue to put on a good show for some weeks.

The choice of F506 for the Peter Seabrook Award was a challenge, with strong competition from many varieties. Several stood out, but F506 put on an amazing show of orange and yellow striped blooms and the open centres of the flowers attracted plenty of pollinators. The health and vigour of the plant have been very good with excellent disease resistance. It has a slight perfume and is just a rose that makes you feel warm and happy, like little blooms of sunshine.

The Pollinator Award on the other hand, was an easy choice. M501 from Lens Roses was quite simply full of life and diversity from day one. Its open nature and slight scent are a real attractant. Whilst it may not have scored as highly as the others, I believe that this will be a fabulous landscape rose which will encourage a wide variety of insects in any planted situation. This is a rose to keep an eye out for in the future.
